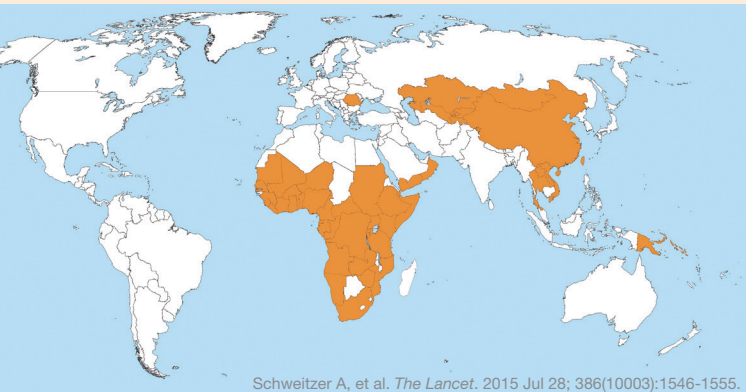


Hepatitis

six months. You might also need treatment.
